Dr Omerhodzic is a consultant neurosurgeon at Department of neurosurgery, Clinical Center University of Sarajevo, the main and largest university hospital in Bosnia-Herzegovina. He was trained in many different countries (Germany, Sweden, Slovenia, Austria, United States etc.) by the World famous neurosurgeons.

As a chair of the Division of general neurosurgery and spine he is specialized in brain tumor surgery, both in adults and children, including those affecting brainstem, ventricular and periventricular tumors, sellar, parasellar and pineal region tumours, but also performs cerebrovascular and spine surgeries at daily basis.

His clinical and teaching efforts are focused on perfecting surgical techniques, for young neurosurgeons and residents in his group. He is serving as faculty member of EANS Training Committee.

As the Secretary of the national neurosurgical society dr Omerhodzic is leading person for establishing contemporary educational training concept and almost all scientific meetings in the country. As a member of organizing committee for many scientific meetings, both national and international, he is deeply focused for team work.

He has published more than 50 articles and several book chapters and has more than 90 scientific conference presentations. Dr Omerhodzic has privilege to give the lectures as an invited faculty on a number of international neurosurgical courses including SEENS (Neurooncology Committee Chair), EANS, AANS and WFNS meetings. He is prominent member of Bosnian-Herzegovinian American Academy of Arts and Sciences (BHAAAS). Dr Omerhodzic is Federal Permanent Court Expert for neurosurgery.
